Swiss-based Infonoia has won a U.S. mandate for Eclipse/OSGi-based Rich Server Platform

Geneva, Switzerland, 12 October 2006 - Infonoia, a professional organization providing software and services surrounding enterprise open-source Java solutions, announced today that it has won a U.S. mandate to migrate an Integrated Enterprise Business System to Java EE standard, making use of Rich Server Platform (RSP).



Riverside County Office of Education, California, United States, has chosen Swiss-based Infonoia because of its worldwide unique expertise in a combination of semi-automated migration to Java EE standard as well as server-side Eclipse and deep integration OSGi which are at the core of Rich Server Platform (RSP).

Rich Server Platform (RSP) is a next-generation, yet standards-based, open-source software that enhances business flexibility and optimizes business processes through deep integration of software components. Infonoia had initiated the open-source project in May 2006 to which 12 committers from 3 continents contribute to date.

Rich Server Platform (RSP) leverages mature and open technologies and standards such as Eclipse Rich Client Platform (Eclipse RCP), the OSGi specifications, and established web technologies such as JSF, JSP/JSTL, LZX/Laszlo, PHP, Struts and Wicket for rich user interfaces.

The legacy version of the enterprise application to be migrated has 450 screens, runs in a cluster of 8 servers and handles several billion USD in financial transactions per year.

Infonoia - a merge of the words information and paranoia - is a software and services company headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland. The company specializes in Java web applications and open source, and is leading the open-source project Rich Server Platform (RSP).
